Nocivelli, Tozzi, and Martina at the Opening Conference of Refrigera 2025

BolognaFiere, Wednesday, November 5

Cormano, October 21, 2025 - The opening conference of Refrigera 2025, the international refrigeration fair of industrial, commercial, logistics refrigeration, freezing and cryogenics organized by A151 srl and taking place at BolognaFiere from November 5 to 7, promises to feature prominent speakers.

The event, titled "Sustainability: Refrigeration at the Center", is organized by the magazine ZeroSottoZero of Tecniche Nuove, in collaboration with Refrigera and Assofrigoristi (the Italian Association of Refrigeration Specialists). It will host:

- Marco Nocivelli, Vice President of Confindustria with responsibility for industrial policies and Made in Italy, and CEO of Epta;
- Mario Tozzi, senior researcher at CNR and science communicator on environmental issues;
- Maurizio Martina, Deputy Director of FAO Italy and former Minister of Agricultural, Food and Forestry Policies.

The conference, moderated by Marco Oldrati, Chief Operating Officer of Assofrigoristi, will begin at 10:00 AM in the Lord Kelvin Hall, Pavilion 30. Topics will include the cold chain, energy and environmental sustainability, and the challenge of climate change.

Refrigera 2025 will host around 50 conference sessions featuring leading industry experts. Discussions will cover, among other topics, the cold chain in large-scale retail, alternative refrigerants, cryogenics and applied developments, ultra-low temperatures, insulating materials, CO₂ and propane supply chains, and technologies for process refrigeration in industrial, pharmaceutical, and chemical-plastic sectors.

Refrigera 2025 will also serve as the stage for the PR Planet Refrigeration Awards, the inaugural

edition of awards recognizing excellence in commercial and industrial refrigeration. The awards highlight innovation, sustainability, design, efficiency, and professionalism across the entire supply chain. The multidisciplinary jury includes retail and wholesale managers as well as industry professionals and journalists. The awards ceremony will take place on Thursday, November 6, 2025, at 12:45 PM in the Lord Kelvin Hall, Pavilion 30.

Three weeks before the opening, the exhibition—unique in Italy and a leader in Southern Europe—has already secured over 10,000 gross square meters of exhibition space, exceeding the total of the previous edition (+12%). **More than 300 exhibitors from 25 countries** will attend, including Belgium, China, France, Germany, the Netherlands, Poland, the Czech Republic, the United Kingdom, Spain, Switzerland, Thailand, and Turkey.

Coinciding with Refrigera, Applitech 2025 will take place, the trade fair for components and equipment for household appliances and consumer electronics, organized by A151 srl in collaboration with Senaf/Tecniche Nuove.
